

September 10 2018 Wilson Town Board Meeting

The regular monthly meeting of the Wilson Town Board held on September 10 2018 at the town hall was called to order by Chairman Leon Bowman at 7:00 p.m.

Present was Chairman Leon Bowman, Supervisors Tony Chelmowski, Ernie Culp, Shelby Kammerer and Nate Beyerstedt. Clerk Robin Jandt, Treasurer Karen Haedtke, Zoning Administrator Paul Siebenaler, Fire Chief Josh Murphy.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The agenda was approved by T.Chelmowski and seconded by E.Culp. All approved.

The bills totaling \$ 14,148.28 were approved by T.Chelmowski and seconded by S.Kammerer. All approved.

The minutes from the August 13 2018 meeting were approved by T.Chelmowski and seconded by E.Culp All approved.

Springbrook mail box was discussed. T.Chelmowski still hasn't got a hold of the person. He has tried many times. A decision was made to send a certified letter. L.Bowman will take care of writing a letter. A motion was made by S.Kammerer and seconded by N. Beyerstedt. All approved.

Bridge punch list was discussed. T.Chelmowski replied that they are waiting for Valley View Estates to be gophered.

The Calteaux residence on Stoney Point Road was discussed. T.Chelmowski and N. Beyerstedt will stop in and visit with Brian Calteaux about having stuff in the road right away.

Blackberry project has not been started.. Waiting for Blacktop equipment to come back in to the quarry. Reed's Tree Service has taken a look at the tree's and it will take at least 2 days to remove them.

L.Bowman has received the paper work from MAT for our donation we will take a look at it next month.

The rebate for installing our lights in the town hall had shown up on our May statement.

A town hall person to replace Arlene. L.Bowman knows of someone that would be interested in cleaning but not renting it out. The men's urinal needs to be looked at it needs to be replaced. T.Chelmowski will look in to it. S.Kammerer commented that she can keep taking care of the town hall for now. L.Bowman made a motion and T.Chelmowski seconded. All approved.

The Fire Dept. raffle was discussed. J.Murphy talked about it briefly. It is September 29th a lunch will be served. Tickets for the raffle will also be available for sale.

Echodale Town Line Road was discussed briefly. Everything has been put on hold until the City can get together.

A follow up on the HBCI franchise agreement. Supposedly there is an agreement it was signed in November 1999. A discussion took place. L.Bowman would like to see the whole agreement. He will look in to it some more. S.Kammerer made a motion for L.Bowman to continue looking in to it and E.Culp seconded. All approved.

Tattoo issue was discussed. L.Bowman had talked to someone at the Winona County sheriff's office and it sounds like the issue has been resolved.

The Bublitz's project down on County Road 17 was discussed. L.Bowman has been getting plenty of phone calls. L.Bowman is going to look more in to the excavating issues. The house in Witoka still needs to have a permit. S.Kammerer is going to look in to the feed lot issues. P.Siebenaler will contact Brian Larsen about a permit.

Plow Truck insurance. R.Jandt and T.Chelmowski will look in to finishing up on it.

Treasurer's report was approved by T.Chelmowski and seconded by N.Beyerstedt. All approved.

We had received an annexation request for a property down on Sunny Ridge Drive. They want to be annexed in to the City of Winona so they can sell their property and hook in to City water and sewer. The septic that is on the property now is not compliant. We have received a letter from a certified plumber stating that it fails but nothing else in detail. The board discussed the letter and made the decision that we would like to see something else stating better facts. Carlos from the City of Winona will be notified. E.Culp made a motion and S.Kammerer seconded. All approved.

Propane was discussed. We decided to run a legal and see what we get. This will be looked at next month.

MAT legal training is October 13th in Olmstead County. We should really send someone. If anyone is interested in going we will pay the expenses. L.Bowman made a motion and S.Kammerer seconded. All approved.

A tree was down recently and L.Bowman would like to have a back up for T.Chelmowski in case he can't get a hold of him. It also would be good if 2 people could go just for safety issues. A discussion took place. The list will be Tony Chelmowski, Nate Beyerstedt, Leon Bowman, Ernie Culp and then Shelby Kammerer.

OAA document was discussed. L.Bowman would like a few people to go over the electronic copy. E.Culp will contact Bob Peterson. T.Chelmowski made a motion and S.Kammerer seconded. All approved.

J.Murphy had submitted bills for the ones they had paid and we had received credit back electronically. We will issue checks to them tonight. J.Murphy also commented that he had received a credit back from MSA because they had been paid twice.

T.Chelmowski will contact Richard Job to see if he would be interested in getting on the planning commission.

R.Jandt will be gone in October but Kathy Eide will be available that evening to take the minutes.

There will be a workshop in Mable Mn on September 17 to discuss annexation. A motion was made by E.Culp and seconded by T.Chelmowski to send someone if anyone wants to go.

With no other business E.Culp made a motion to adjourn at 9:10 and S.Kammerer seconded. All approved.
