

## February 12 2018 Wilson Town Board Meeting

The regular monthly meeting of the Wilson Town Board held on February 12 2018 at the town hall was called to order by Chairman Leon Bowman at 7:00 p.m.

Present were Chairman Leon Bowman, Supervisors, Tony Chelmowski, David DeLano, Ernie Culp and Shelby Kammerer. Clerk Robin Jandt, Zoning Administrator Paul Siebenaler, Fire Chief Josh Murphy.

Others Present: List is attached.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The agenda was approved by T.Chelmowski and seconded by S.Kammerer All approved.

The bills totaling \$17,273.11 were approved by T.Chelmowski and seconded by D.DeLano All approved.

The minutes from the January 8 2018 meeting were approved by T.Chelmowski and seconded by D.DeLano All approved.

Due to Karen Haedtke's absent a motion was made by D.DeLano and seconded by T.Chelmowski to let L.Bowman sign all checks on Wed. night at the township officers meeting.

Emily from the Wilson Township activity group. was in attendance to present a project they would like to do. Originally the thought was to redo the playground equipment but after looking in to it was going to be costly. So the activity group would like to replace the tables and chairs in the community hall and then the remaining would go towards ceiling tiles. \$4,000.00 would get us 14 tables and 140 chairs. The tables would be 8 ft. The ceiling tiles that were looked at ran between \$3.00 and \$5.00. A small discussion took place and L.Bowman appointed S.Kammerer to be in charge of heading the group. Emily mentioned if there is any money left the money would go towards the bricks outside for the memorial. T.Chelmowski mentioned that he would like to be involved in the ceiling tiles. T.Chelmowski would like to see the lights get changed over too. LED would be the way to go. T.Chelmowski will get a price on LED lights. Emily mentioned the old tables and chairs would be sold. T.Chelmowski made a motion to go with the tables, chairs and ceiling tiles and S.Kammerer seconded. All approved.

The Country Climbers snowmobile club had two members in attendance .The club would take Witoka's gambling over. The money would be distributed locally. L.Bowman asked if the fire dept. would get a percentage. The answer was yes. Right now we get money from Rollingstone. T.Chelmowski asked how the percentages worked. Sara from the snowmobile club commented it all varies. L.Bowman was glad to see that the money will stay local. After no other discussion S.Kammerer made a motion to approve the Winona Country Climbers gambling permit and T.Chelmowski seconded. All approved.

Josh Murphy reported that the bus is back in service. The International Tanker frame under the tank is rusted through. They got a estimate to see how much it would cost to repair but have not got the estimate back yet. A discussion took place. S.Kammerer made a motion up to \$1,000.00 for repairs on the tanker and E.Culp seconded. All approved.

D.DeLano talked on the budget. The budget is not looking so good right now. We had some major bills go through last month. So hopefully it will look better in the next few months.

No update on CTAS 2018. There is an update that has come out but R.Jandt has not looked into it.

The Planning Commission will hold there public hearing next Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> of February on the rezoning. The board will have there public hearing in March on the 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00.

Spring Brook mail box. T.Chelmowski had gone down and talked to the guy. He will get insurance on the mailbox and we will get a copy of it.

Brenner land annexation was discussed. L.Bowman spent 4 hours working on it today. There are many people involved in this and it could end up being a big issue. L.Bowman proposes getting a hold of the city manager Steve Sarvi and having a meeting. S.Kammerer suggested getting some signs stating closed road to have on hand. S.Kammerer made a motion for T.Chelmowski to get 2 signs and 2 barricades and E.Culp seconded. All approved.

L.Bowman attended WAIDA's annual meeting. A small discussion took place on the meeting. Darren Engler was a guest speaker. Also a gentleman from Fluoramics had asked L.Bowman if he could come up to one of our board meetings and speak on his company. There might be some interest of moving the company out of Winona to possibly the WAIDA property.

The jail house advisory meeting was discussed. It is held once a month. L.Bowman and E.Culp are representatives for the township officers. It has been hard for them to attend the meetings.

The annual meeting was discussed. L.Bowman asked that E.Culp get a report for the gopher fund to R.Jandt . We need to think about a moderator for the meeting. R.Jandt and L.Bowman will work on the agenda. We need to think about the levy for next month.

Treasurer's report was not available because K.Haedtke was out.

R.Jandt went over the board of review audit. It was reviewed by the board. T.Chelmowski made a motion to approve the audit and D.DeLano seconded. All approved.

Election judges were announced. They will be Troy Evans, Bob Peterson and Gail Schwanbeck. T.Chelmowski made a motion to approve the Election judges and E.Culp seconded. All approved. R.Jandt did comment that she is always looking for Election judges so if anyone ever has any ideas please let her know.

MAT lobby day is coming up. R.Jandt plans on attending.

The buffer ordinance meeting at Winona County was attended by E.Culp. A small discussion took place.

D.DeLano announced that he will be attending the old settlers this year and will be the guest speaker. D.DeLano will be speaking on the history of his property.

S.Kammerer commented that Winona County has no one in charge of feedlots at this time.

T.Chelmowski commented that the plow truck is down at Debushe in LaCrosse being repaired. It will probably be about \$6,000.00.

L.Bowman will be getting information on evasive species and will pass it on as soon as he gets it. There also maybe some grant money available.

Water test came back and all is well.

With no other business T.Chelmowski made a motion to adjourn at 8:50 and D.DeLano seconded. All approved.
