Wilson Township private driveways must be clear of trees branches

Emergency vehicles need adequate space to provide services

The Wilson Township Volunteer Fire Department and the Wilson Township Board of Supervisors are requesting that all Wilson Township homeowners clear their driveway of obstructions (tree branches, hedges, etc.). In the event of an emergency, fire and rescue vehicles need clearance space in order to function properly.

Our Fire Chief has requested that Wilson Township home owners clear their driveway with a 12' wide X 12' tall lane through the entire length of their driveway, and then maintain that area periodically. This will ensure that township vehicles and volunteer fire department personnel are able to respond safely and quickly should an emergency situation occur. Tree branches are the main cause of concern. This simple and sensible maintenance request could make a huge difference!
